CONTRACT FOR SPACE

Agreement dated this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between _____ of _____ (herein after called Exhibitor/User) and the Franklin County Agricultural Society. (herein after called the Society.)

In consideration of the sum of _____, the Society agrees to provide and the Exhibitor/User agrees to occupy and use _____ front feet of inside/ outside space during the following dates of the Farmington Fair, namely Sept. ____ thru ____ , 20 ____ inclusive.

Full payment of the above stated amount shall be made to the Society on or before July 1, 20____. Failure to remit the full amount gives the Society the right to offer the space to another party.

It is further agreed that if the Exhibitor/User fails to occupy the designated space, or fails to notify the Society of a legitimate reason for being tardy, by 10:00 a.m., Saturday, September ____ 20____, the Society may, at it's option and without notice, offer the space to any other party, with no guarantee to the above mentioned Exhibitor/User for an equivalent space elsewhere.

The Exhibitor/User shall not assign or sublet any space contracted for without the written consent of the appropriate Society Officials.

The Society shall not be responsible for cancellation of the Fair due to Fire, Flood, Acts of War or any hazard beyond the control of the Society, nor will it be held responsible for any damages occurring during the Fair for such hazards beyond its control, nor shall the Society be required to refund prepaid rental fees whatsoever.

The Exhibitor/User agrees to provide proof of LIABILITY INSURANCE from a company licensed to do business in the State of Maine in the amount of not less than \$500,000, naming the Society as co-insured.

The Exhibitor/User further agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Society, its Officers, Officials, employees and agents from any and all claims and losses accruing to or resulting from any person or persons who may be injured on the premises occupies by the Exhibitor/User.

The Exhibitor/User further agrees to comply with any and all applicable Federal, State and Local Laws, and the regulations and rules of the Society including those printed on the back of this document.

Neither this contract nor any provision thereof can be changed or modified or discharged in whole or in part except in writing, signed on behalf of the Society by authorized representative thereof.

Rules & Regulations

Note: This document is considered a part of the space rental contract printed on the reverse of this page.

FAIR HOURS

Opening Hours of the fair are 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. or beyond at the discretion of Fair Officials. AT NO TIME UNLESS PERMITTED BY FAIR OFFICIALS, ARE EXHIBITORS/USERS TO CLOSE OR SUSPEND OPERATIONS. SATURDAY (FINAL DAY) IS NOT AN EXCEPTION. Parties who attempt to move-out early risk future invitations to participate.

CHECK-IN

All concessionaires/exhibitors are required to check in with the appropriate Facility Supervisor immediately upon arrival. Contract obligations are to be met prior to set-up.

EXHIBITORS/VENDORS PRESENCE

Exhibitors are encouraged to man their facility at all times during normal Fair Hours. This will be left to their discretion. Franklin County Agricultural Society will not be responsible for your exhibit during normal Fair Hours.

VEHICLE DELIVERIES

Safety regulations & State Law prohibit use of unauthorized motor vehicles in midway & exhibition areas during normal Fair Hours. If necessary to convey goods & supplies during Fair Hours, hand carts & similar conveyances are recommended.

PROHIBITED PRODUCTS TO BE OFFERED FOR SALE OR AS PRIZES

It is the Rules of the Society that the following items are NOT to be offered for sale or as prizes:

STINK BOMBS

SILLY STRING

BLOW GUNS & DARTS

COLOR HAIR SPRAY

POP ROCKS

LASER LIGHTS

KNIFES & SWORDS

NOTE; This list may be modified at any time by the Society as the need to protect the public arises.

WASTE WATER DISPOSAL

Grey waters are to be disposed of only at designated facilities. Surface water drain systems are NOT for dumping grey water. Failure to comply risks future invitations to participate.

DOGS PROHIBITED

Except for working animals, dogs are prohibited from all Midway, Exhibition and Vending areas. It is requested the Animals be kept out of sight from public view.

EXHIBIT/VENDING AREA APPEARANCE

Well maintained, clean & attractive facilities are appreciated by Fair patrons. The Society maintains the right to require improvements if necessary.

SOUND SYSTEMS - USE OF HIGH VOLUME SOUND SYSTEMS IS NOT PERMITTED

Ordinary video & audio presentations are to be used at comfortable decibel levels.
